Chord progression for the third staff: C E/c⁷ F E/a⁷ Dm G⁷ C B/e⁷

Chord progression for the fourth staff: Am / Dm / Dm⁷ G⁷ C C - G⁷

Chord progression for the fifth staff: C A⁷ Dm⁷ / Dm⁷ G⁷ C # B/e⁷

Chord progression for the sixth staff: Am G/am⁷ F/dm⁷ # Dm⁷ = Dm⁷ G⁷ C C

This also works if you transpose the last 8 bars up an octave on the final play through.
