Chord progression for 'Long Island Iced Tea':

Staff 1: D F#/d7 Em7 / Em7 / Em7 A7

Staff 2: D D#/b7 Em7 G#/e7 A A/em7 A7 D - A7 A7 D - A7

Staff 3: D F#/d7 Em7 G/em7 A / Em7 A7

Staff 4: D Bm7 Em G#/e7 A/em7 A7 D D - A7

Staff 5: D Bm7 Em7 / Em7 A7 B/em7 C#/a7

Staff 6: D Bm7 Em G#/e7 A/em7 A7 D D

- Bars 1 – 8 1st couple set twice then turn with the right hand and cast off one place (2nd couple step up on bars 7 and 8).
- Bars 9 – 16 2nd, 1st and 3rd couple dance a reel of three on the sidelines. 1st couple cross down (no hands) to 3rd place on opposite side to enter the reels. 1st couple finish in 2nd place opposite side.
- Bars 17 – 20 1st couple dance a half figure of eight down through the 3rd couple and cast up to 2nd place own side.
- Bars 21 – 24 1st and 3rd couples turn by the right hand.
- Bars 25 – 32 2nd and 1st couple dance rights and lefts.

Repeat having passed a couple.
